Cedar Roofs Are Our Specialty



Cedar is elegant, attractive, and naturally resistant to rot and decay. When properly maintained, cedar roofs can last 40 years or more. The challenge here in Hawaii is that we have a climate that creates an environment ideal for bacteria growth. Surrounding trees, foliage and damp conditions are the foundation for growing moss, lichen, mold, algae and fungi. By acting like a sponge and holding moisture against a roof, these infestations rapidly accelerate cedar's rot and decay. Like our teeth, cedar is an organic material which needs to be cleaned to stay healthy. Neglect your teeth and we know what happens. Neglect your cedar roof, and you will get similar results, rot and decay.



We Are Cedar Roof Cleaning Experts

There are those that will clean a cedar roof and there are those that are cedar roof cleaners. Paradise Pressure Washing LLC technicians are cedar roof cleaning experts.

We use only a non-pressure cleaning process. We DO NOT power wash roofs, which the Cedar Shingle and Shake Bureau strongly cautions against. Instead, our process is specifically developed to appropriately clean and treat cedar shakes and shingles. All rinsing is done with garden hose pressure.

All cleaning is done from a ladder with a few exceptions where our technicians may need to reach inaccessible areas. We avoid crushing gutters or damaging trim by using "standoffs." When deemed necessary, surrounding landscaping is protected during the cleaning process by water rinsing. Care is taken to ensure that hoses do not damage landscaping.





Cedar Roof Facts

Cedar is a natural insulator against the environment. Cedar has twice the thermal resistivity (R-value) of asphalt, 5 times that of slate, 8 times that of concrete and hundreds of times that of metal and aluminum.

Cedar roofs do not decay, but they do weather. It has natural preservatives that resist moisture, decay and insect damage. In warm, humid climates and heavily shaded roofs, algae, moss, mildew, lichen and fungi will grow. Because these organisms retain moisture, the cedar will decay in time if not maintained.

New shakes and shingles display the natural honey and cinnamon tones and will later mature to a seasoned and distinguished-looking silvery gray when properly maintained. If the shakes or shingles display a dark brown to black tone, these are signs of harmful organism infestations and they need to be cleaned.

With a proper cedar roof maintenance program, a cedar roof will last from 40 to 60 years.
